<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>State ruled by a king</li> <li>Rule is hereditary</li> <li>Some rulers claim divine right</li> <li>Practiced in Mycenae by 2000 B.C.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>State ruled by nobility</li> <li>Rule is hereditary and based on family ties, social rank, wealth</li> <li>Social status and wealth support rulers' authority</li> <li>Practiced in Athens prior to 594 B.C.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>State ruled by a small group of citizens</li> <li>Rule is based on wealth or ability</li> <li>Ruling group controls military</li> <li>Practiced in Sparta by 500 B.C.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>State ruled by its citizens</li> <li>Rule is based on citizenship</li> <li>Majority rule decides vote</li> <li>Practiced in Athens by about 500 B.C.</li> </ul>
