 - Affirmative One- 30 sec-1 min
 - Negative One- 30 sec-1 min
 - Affirmative Two- 30 sec-1 min
 - Negative Two- 30 sec-1 min
- Moderator concludes debate

1. Were the Native Americans more advanced than the Europeans?

Suggested Topics: The Meaning of Advancement (start by considering this from as many angles as possible!), North American Peoples, Aztecs, Maya, Ball Game, Inca, Guns, Germs, Steel, Renaissance, Pizarro, Cortes, Draft Animals, Printing Press, Thirty Years War, Scientific Revolution, so many possible examples!

2. Should we celebrate the discovery of America by Columbus?

Suggested Topics: Columbian Exchange, Draft Animals, New Foods, Slavery, Disease, Imperialism, Da Gama, Racism, Genocide, Manifest Destiny, Inflation, Mercantilism, Origins of Columbus Day, Leif Erikson, Pizza, Ice Cream, and you are strongly encouraged to look at how all these things have impacted the world in which we live today, as long as you show the links!

Suggested Topics: Forms of Slavery, Slavery in Africa, Chattel, Patron-Client System, Wealth in People, Dahomey, Kongo, Asante, Olaudah Equiano, slave experiences, King Afonso, there is a lot that you can do with the topic, but do not neglect the sources I already gave you!

4. Is absolute rule the best form of government?

Suggested Topics: Louis XIV (France), Peter and Catherine the Great (Russia), the Stuart Kings, the English Civil War, and the English Bill of Rights (England), Habsburgs and the Thirty Years War (Holy Roman Empire), Akbar the Great (Mughal India), Suleiman the Magnificent (Ottoman Empire), Shi Huangdi (Qin China), the Roman Republic and the Roman Empire (Rome), Athenian Democracy (Greece), Achaemenid Persia (Persia), Enlightenment Thinkers and Enlightened Monarchs (Europe), Bureaucracy, the advice of Machiavelli, American Revolution (USA), feel free to connect to today, just show how it connects!

Suggested Topics: Renaissance, Protestant Reformation, Scientific Revolution, Paper Money, Bank Checks, Gunpowder Empires (Ottomans, Safavids, Mughals), Hundred Years War, European conquest in the New World (Aztec, Inca) and Old World (Africa, India, Southeast Asia), Imperialism, Slavery, Spanish Armada and Naval Warfare, the Thirty Years War, the Seven Years War, the Enlightenment, the American Revolution, basically anything important that involves killing or knowledge during this period!
